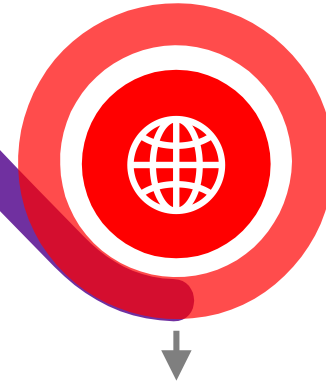
Adaptive Change

Social context: Thriving communities.

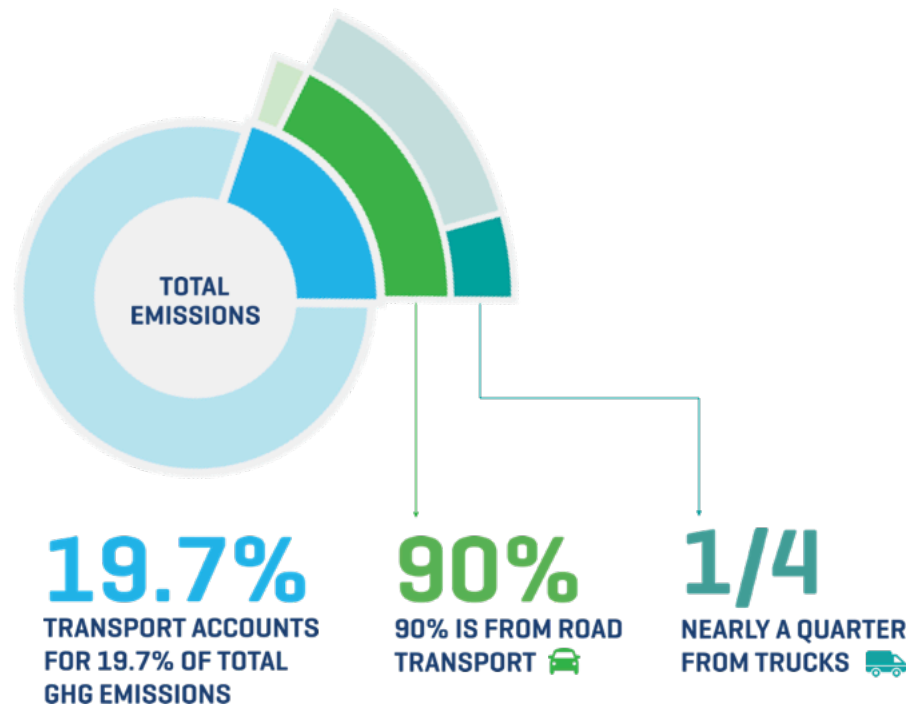
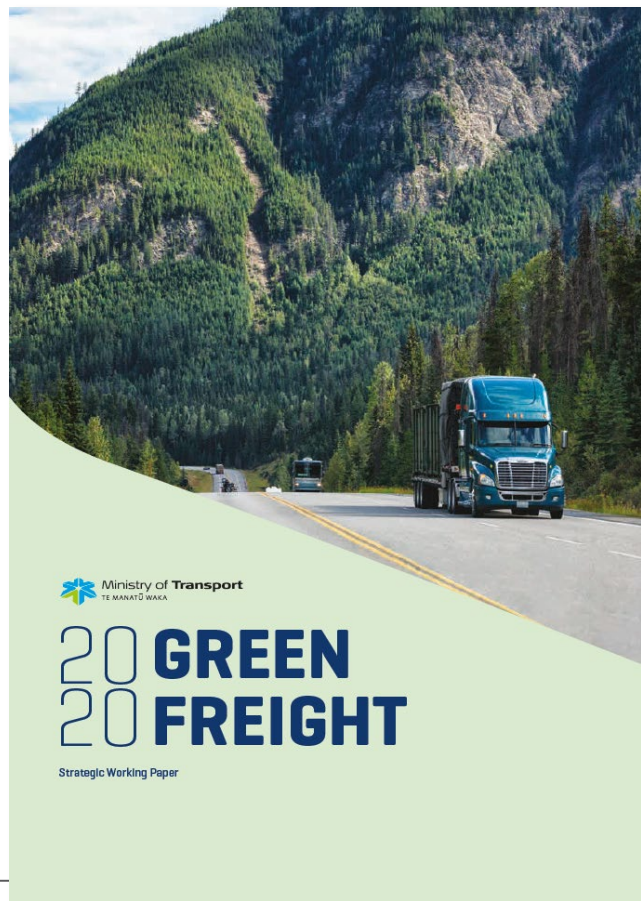
