

Transport and Cities Expert Greg Lindsay to Keynote T-Tech in Auckland

International Transport expert Greg Lindsay will be speaking in New Zealand at the T-Tech conference on 19 – 20 March 2018. Organised by Intelligent Transport Systems New Zealand (ITSNZ), T-Tech will look at new transport technologies and emerging business models and how they will impact government, transport planning, urban design and communities.

Greg is a senior fellow of NewCities Foundation, a non-profit organization dedicated to making cities more inclusive, connected, healthy and vibrant. Greg has advised Samsung, Starbucks, Audi, Chrysler, Emaar, and Expo 2020, among many other organizations. He is co-author of Aerotropolis: The Way We'll Live Next and at NewCities he led the work on "Now Arriving: A Connected Mobility Roadmap for Public Transport".
