July

Resource Management Review Panel recommends replacement of the RMA, five years after release of our joint [Integrated Governance, Planning and Delivery](#) thought leadership report.

August

New water regulator Taumata Arowai is established, enabling independent quality regulation of water services, following our 2017 delegation to Scotland and summary report [Lessons from Scotland](#).

November

March

Government announces a new scale development aligned with strategic infrastructure investment in Auckland's south, three years after Infrastructure New Zealand's [Innovation City](#) white paper was launched.

July

November

Ministry of Transport releases a proposal to revolutionise transport funding and charging, eight years after INZ predecessor NZCID demonstrated [public support for tolling of the strategic network](#).
